

# Sharing our story: Rainwater harvesting system for flushing toilets at Stratford Methodist Church



Dr Lim Ho from the church's Eco Church team says, 'We installed a Stormsave rainwater harvesting system in 2014. It works very well, saving about 70,000 litres of tap water annually for flushing the toilets. It was not cheap (£8k) and, as we have no water meter and the water bill for religious settings is low, financially we had no gain. However, our building is heavily used by the community, so the use of rainwater for flushing the toilets, together with our support of the Toilet Twinning scheme is a very good indication of our commitment to a sustainable world. If your church building is heavily used and the installation is cheaper, it is a good way to save tap water.'
